

New Bin Filler

A new development by Fruit Handling Systems Ltd, www.fruithandling.co.nz is the Rotofiller III (RF III), fully automatic, swing-over bin filler.

This machine is finding favour in the U.S.A. in pre-sizing situations. In New Zealand the RF III is in demand for high volume bin filling of export fruit and for binning pre-graded fruit for C/A storage.

The RF III operates on similar principles to the Rotofiller II but provides a superior soft and level fill at approximately 30% higher feed rates.

Bins sit flat on the floor and can be handled by trolley jacks. The RF III is fitted with wheels for ease of movement and versatility.

The PLC controlled RF III automatically fills the first bin, then switches off, swings to the adjacent empty bin and repeats the filling cycle.

The operator need only keep the filler supplied with bins; a big increase in operator productivity.

The standard RF III fills to a very consistent and adjustable volume fill. A "weight fill" option is also being developed to produce accurate net bin fill weight where this is required.
